**Note1: Guidance for watching matches.**

- Kudo was created in Japan in 1981 with the following 4 main factors. 1) realism through full-contact fighting 2) safety for athletes 3) clarity/understandability in scoring/determination of victory 4) possibility for one to keep practicing for a lifetime, beyond the age of 50-60.
- Kudo expanded rapidly across the globe, and aims at a participation in the Olympic Games. Next year in 2014, the 4th Kudo World Championship will be held in Tokyo, with 80 participating countries.
- Immediate victory (IPPON) can be obtained by punches or kicking techniques leading to a 4-seconds knock-down or by tap-out following submission by choke or lock. Aside from IPPON, 3 other categories of points exist, counting towards final victory.
- Kudo takes into account the weight advantage in throws/ground fight as well as the size advantage in standing position and [rather than weight classes] created 7 classes following a physical index determined as the sum of the size (in cm) and the weight (in kg) of the athletes.

**Note2 :** The fight card may change depending on the fighters' physical condition or personal circumstances.

**N.B.** 1) Ippon=8 Points, Wazaari=4 Points, Yuko=2 Points, kouka=1 point. / 2) Competitor who ends up with more points declared winner. 3) In case both competitor have the same number of points, the competitor who has points with higher value win. E.g. A( 1 Yuko +2 Koukas =4 points ) wins over B (4 koukas=4 points) 4) No sub main referee system. Draw will be declared only when 2 red flags and 2 white flags are shown. **N.B.** This is not a fixed rule, but a trial in order to determine if such system, also showing the number of points, improves the easiness of understanding the decisions for the audience.
